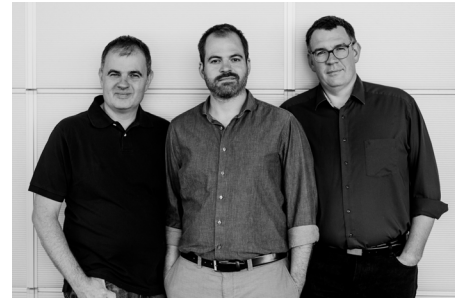




St. Laurent Ried Frauenfeld 2018 BIO



From uncertain origin and nowadays observed as an austrian speciality these wines of the St. Laurent grapes impress with a bouquet reminding on forest fruits and sour cherries. From our single vineyard Frauenfeld we harvest a selection of St. Laurent grapes from over 40 year old vines.

age of the rootstocks	about 35 years
soil	limestone, alluvial land
training form	high training system (75 cm trunk height)
harvested on	4 th till 8 th of October
vinification	skin contact for 16 days, spontaneous fermentation in big oak casks, 20% whole cluster, fermentation temperature was between 29°C and 31°C, aged in small barrels (225 L, french, slawonian and austrian oak) for 14 months
aging ability	5 to 10 years of harvest
recommendation for dishes	this wine fits excellent to game, roast and dark meat
service help	big red wine glass



alcohol 13% vol **acidity 5.9 ‰** **residual sugar 1.6 g/l**
