<b>Wine name/ Variety</b>	Loibner Grüner Veltliner
<b>Style</b>	Trockenbeerenauslese
<b>Viticulturist</b>	Knoll family
<b>Location</b>	Wachau/ Unter-Loiben
<b>Elevation/ Altitude</b>	240 – 350 m
<b>Exposition</b>	from the foot of the mountain and terraced vineyards with southern exposition
<b>Soil type</b>	different soils from all Grüner Veltliner single vineyards
<b>Vineyard's style</b>	grapes from different vineyards
<b>Methods of training</b>	modified Moser Training System
<b>Density of planting</b>	different density (Kreutles, Loibenberg, Kellerberg)
<b>Average vine age of this vineyard</b>	
<b>Yield restriction</b>	our sweet wines happen to be depending on weather conditions, so the yield usually is very small, only from selected botrytised grapes.
<b>Harvesting</b>	by hand green harvest if necessary
<b>Selective harvest/ sorting tables</b>	yes / no sorting tables

### VINIFICATION

<b>Destemming, whole bunch, carbonic maceration, press type</b>	no destemming, skin contact, no carbonic maceration, pneumatic press
<b>Yeast</b>	cultured and natural yeast
<b>Fermentation vessel – size &amp; material</b>	glass ballons and stainless steel tank from 25 to 100 liters depending on batch quantity
<b>Fermentation – length &amp; temperature</b>	various length, 22 - 25 degrees
<b>Malolactic – when &amp; where</b>	no
