Tasting Notes

Brilliant golden with green nuances, ripe stone fruits, yellow quinces, apricots and elegant spicy and herbal notes appear in the nose, full-bodied and mineralic on the palate, lively structure and a long and multi-faceted finish.

The Vineyard

50 years old grapevines! In this vineyard 17 different grape varieties were planted together - ranging from well-known varieties like Chardonnay, Grüner Veltliner, Riesling, Pinot Blanc or Malvasier to less-known and „old“ varieties like Roter Veltliner, Weiße Vöslauer or Silberweiße. The combination of these varieties is the basis of an elegant, characterful and complex wine.

Alcohol content: 13,0 % vol., acidity: 5,5 g/l, residual sugar: 1,8 g/l (dry)

Serving suggestion

This wine displays a multi-layered bouquet ranging from fruity notes like stone fruits, quinces and peaches via herbs to mineralic notes and is therefore an ideal partner for a wide range of international meals. Because of the complex structure and the full body, this wine can be also matched with hearty and spicy food.
